With optional tees, this 9-hole, 4119 yards, PAR 62 course provides challenging golf for all abilities. Green fees offer excellent value for money and all players are welcome. Once a year we play host and donate use of the course to one of the local golfing societies (FUGS) and their friends, all in aid of raising money for local charities and good causes. Course Rules

At Penlanlas we have just a few rules, to ensure the safety of all visitors and smooth running of the course:

- * The maximum in any one match of game is four persons.
- * The maximum number of persons to a golf set is two.
- * Trolleys and golf bags must not be taken onto greens, tees or into bunkers.
- * Keep up with the match ahead, not ahead of the match behind.
- * Areas beyond any fence, hedge or lines of white posts are out of bounds
- * All ponds, streams and ditches are 'regular' water hazards.
- * Hire of buggies is at owner's discretion and anyone found to be abusing them would be asked to leave the course immediately without refund.
